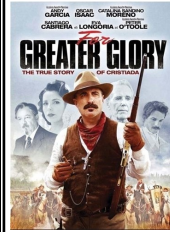

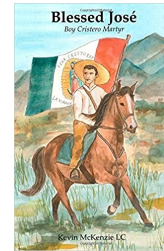
# Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary time, October 24, 2021

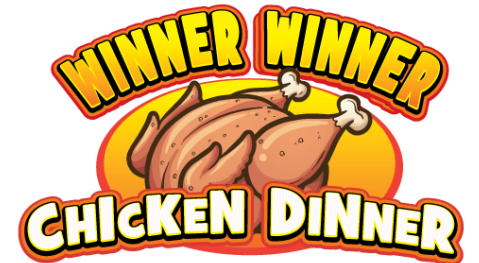
